Next term the children will be learning more about the weather. They will be observing the weather over a couple of weeks and then using the information/data recorded to create a weather report. In preparation for this, we would like you to support your child with their homework, so that they are ready to share their amazing work after the half term.

Task 1 - Weather Wheel

We would like the children to gain a better understanding of the different types of weather. To help with this, they need to create a 'weather wheel' (as pictured). Children need to identify the different types of weather and then draw a picture to represent each weather type, on a plate. They then need to cut out an arrow and attach this to the plate. Finally chn will spin the arrow to identify what the weather is like each day.

Task 2 - Weather Report

The next task is for children to create a weather report. As children identify the weather each day (by looking outside and spinning the arrows on their plate), they will then need to write this information down. They need to write what the weather is like and then write a few sentences describing that particular weather.
