Writing - Our English units will mainly link in with our History topic, 'The Romans'.

We will be:

- Reading and writing our own myth based on Romulus and Remus;
- Writing recounts within the context of the Roman invasion.
- Writing stories with historical descriptions or settings.
- Creating play scripts to explore relationships between historical figures.

Reading - During Guided Reading the children will focus on:

- Developing different reading strategies;
- Improving their comprehension skills using Reciprocal Reading to deepen understanding.

They will be taught to:

- Provide evidence from the text;
- Make sensible predictions;
- Clarify meanings;
- Summarise a text.

Computing



Computing will be included within all subjects, but we will have a specific focus on 'Scratch' which is software which allows children to explore programming. Throughout the term we will also be discussing online safety.

Maths

In Maths we will aim to master:

- Length;

Science

We are learning about Sound. We will explore:

- How sounds are made and how they travel;
- How sounds can be changed.

Our second topic will be 'States of Matter', covering:

- Grouping materials together according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases;
- Exploring how materials can change state when they are heated or cooled;
- The water cycle.

Homework is a continuation of school work at home and is a great opportunity for your child to practice the skills they have learnt.

Reading - For the children to progress in their reading, they need to read aloud daily. Please write a short comment in their reading log to communicate to us how they are reading at home.

Spellings - Weekly spellings should be practiced at home daily using the Read, Write, Look, Cover, Check strategy.

English - Please check your child's homework book. Homework will relate to the unit of work for that week. We expect a high standard of writing, the same as we would expect in a lesson.

Maths - Activities are given based on the unit of work taught that week.

Children also need to learn their times tables off by heart at home up to 12x12.

Speak Up! - A poem will be given to be learned off by heart at the beginning of each half term. These will be performed in an assembly each half term.



History



History - Our topic will be about The Romans.

Children will:

- Learn about Julius Caesar's attempted invasion in 55 - 54 BC.
- We will study the power of the Roman army, successful Roman invasions and the British resistance through exploring who Boudicca was.
- Explore a timeline of Roman history.
