Pupils confidently asked a range of fascinating questions and were intrigued by all the new things that they had learnt. As this was a local Gurdwara, some of our pupils have been there before for worship, which was exciting to hear! It was an amazing experience for the pupils as it taught them about the diverse community in which we live.

Pupils walked there sensibly and enjoyed learning about the rituals, beliefs and customs of Hinduism. They were very respectful and understanding of the different practices present in other religions. They observed the temple rituals, asked excellent questions and also listened attentively. They were amazed to see the statue of Hanuman, which is the largest in Europe. A pupil commented that he found the music very soothing and calm.

Covid Update:

Please do not send your child into school if they have the following symptoms:



- High temperature - A high temperature is usually considered to be 38C or above.
- New, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- Loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
- Diarrhoea

Children do not need to self isolate if a family member tests positive for Covid-19. However, they are encouraged to have lateral flow tests taken daily. If your child shows any of the above symptoms, please take your child for a PCR covid test and inform the school immediately.

If anyone tests positive for the omicron variant, all close contacts must self isolate for 10 days.
