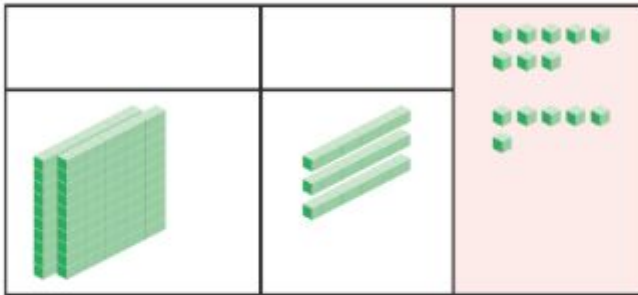
Method 2

$$8 + 6 = 14$$

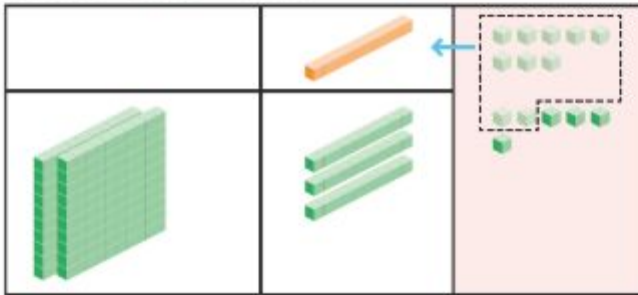

14 ones = 1 ten + 4 ones



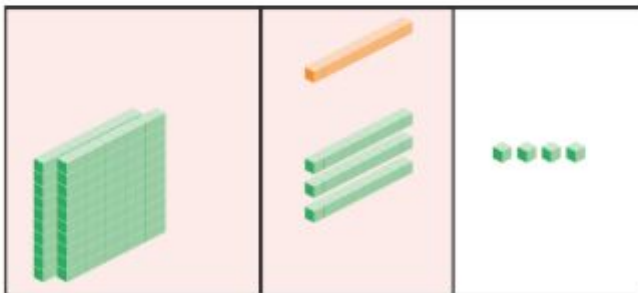
