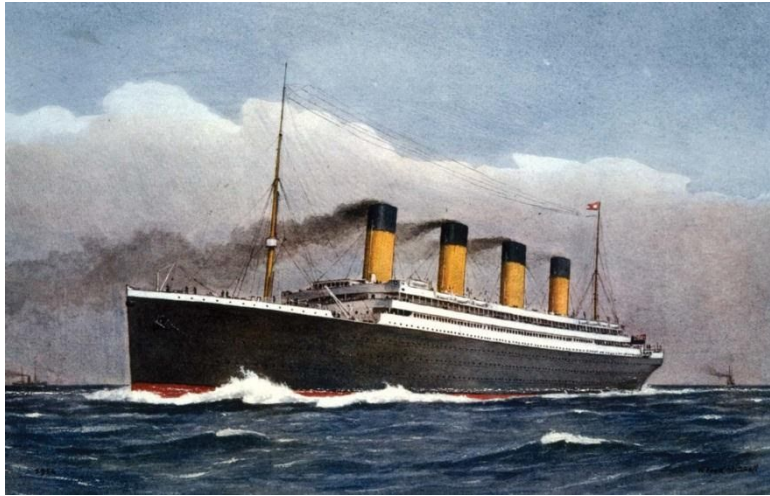


Week 2: English-Task L.O: To use descriptive writing techniques.

Over the week, your task is to write a story based on the tragic event of the Titanic. Your story should center around a family who are on board the Titanic. Remember to include key characters: Captain Smith, Frederick Fleet, Bruce Ismay and William Murdoch. Read the fact files to help you remember their role.

Your story should include a **description** of the setting and main characters. It should also contain interesting dialogue between the characters using speech marks.



Monday: Plan your story. Then write the opening, paragraph 1:

Introduce the family boarding the Titanic. Describe the main characters and include feelings towards the voyage they are about to set off.

Tuesday: Write the build-up, paragraph 2:

Describe the Titanic. What is family doing on the Titanic? Are they eating in the dining room? Dancing? Looking out into the blue sea? Maybe they have a conversation with one of the crew members? Do they notice anything strange?

Wednesday: Write the problem, paragraph 3: What does the family do when the ship hits the iceberg? How do they feel? What are other passengers around them doing? Use your 5 senses.

Thursday: Write the resolution, paragraph 4: What happens to the family? Do they leave safely on the rescue boats? Is anyone left behind?

Friday: Write ending, paragraph 5: '5 year later...'

What has become of this family? What are they now doing? How have they grown and changed? What have they learnt from this tragic event?

Edit and improve your writing.
