### Wake and Shake (10 minutes max)

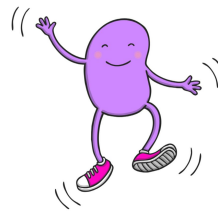
- Let's learn about exercising!

- Grandma?



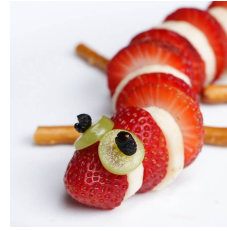
Have a go at describing a character and let your adult guess!

Get really creative and use a variety of fruit to make your favourite animal.

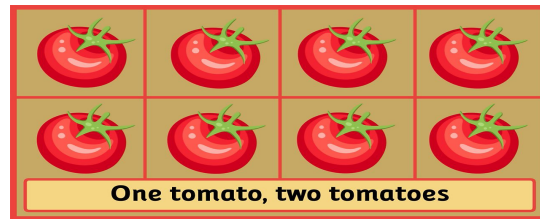
Can you describe your animal?



**Mathematics :** Let's sing a number rhyme

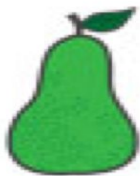

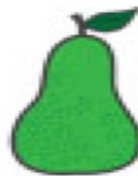


Lets count to 20. Jump as you are counting. Let's start from 20 and stop at 10.

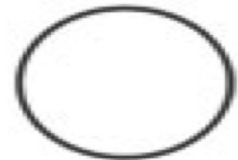

### Additional activities to do daily

- Correctly write your name using a capital letter for the first letter only.
- Learn to read and write these tricky words: he, she, we, me, be, are, to, do
- Practise your handwriting- make sure you are forming your letters and numbers correctly.
- Read your books.

### Storytime

Let your child use their toys to tell you stories that you've shared. When you're sharing a story together ask why your child thinks something has happened, what might happen next or how they think the story might end?

- Use different voices, like loud voices or squeaky voices, when we're telling stories.

Let your child play with their toys and take a break!

### **Rubbish monsters:**

Use an empty cardboard box to make your very own rubbish monster to gobble up all your bits of rubbish! Using an empty facial tissue box is great as the hole for the mouth is already there. But don't worry if you do not have this, other boxes are just as good and you can cut the mouth however big/small you want!

Help your child decorate their box with paint, paper, glitter, pom poms, feathers etc. Using white paper/card, cut out some triangles for the teeth and circles for the eyes and stick in place. Your rubbish monster is now complete! Talk to your child about the different colours and materials they are using and what are they using it for. Discuss why it is important to tidy up.
