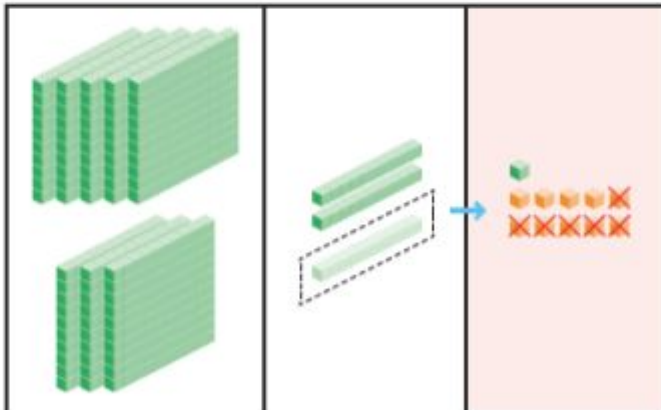

## Let's Learn

Subtract 26 from 831.

Step 1 Regroup 1 ten into 10 ones.  
Subtract the ones.

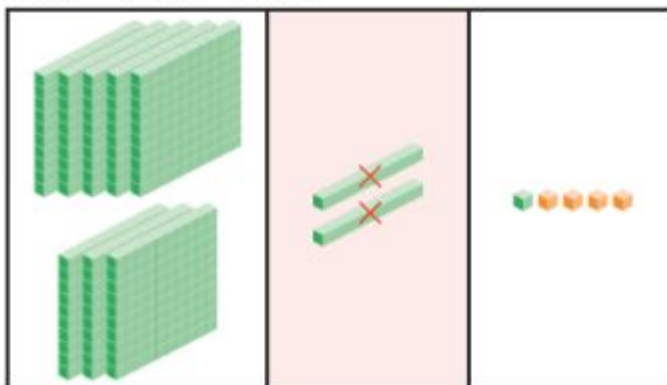
**11 ones** - 6 ones = 5 ones

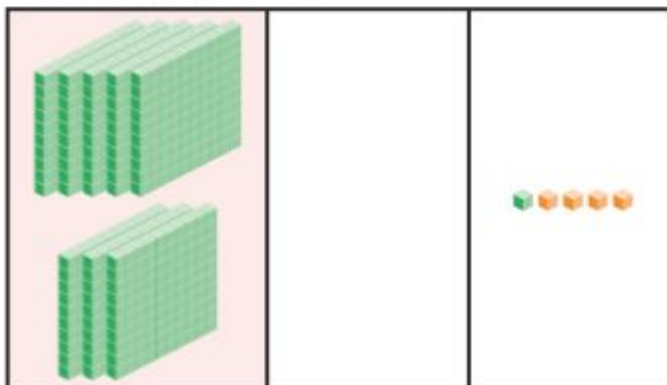


Step 2 Subtract the tens.  
 $2 \text{ tens} - 2 \text{ tens} = 0 \text{ tens}$

Step 3 Subtract the hundreds.

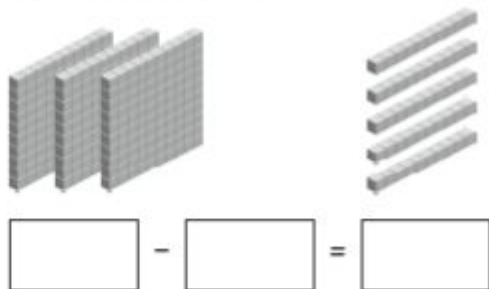

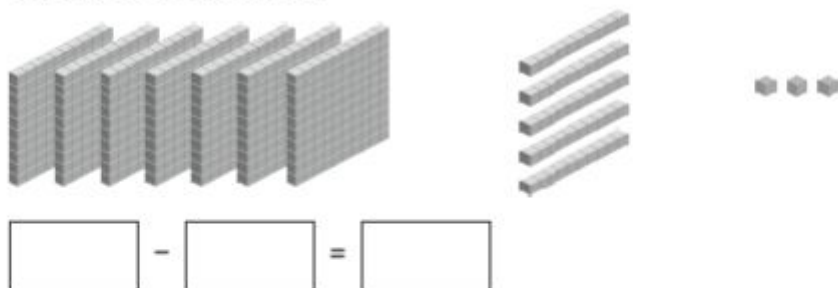
