# Non-chronological reports

Non-chronological reports don't have to  
be read in **any order**.

# Features of a non-chronological report:

**Introduction -**  
What is the report about?

**Sub-headings -**  
Separate your information.

**Paragraphs -**  
Facts about your topic.

**Present Tense -**  
Imagine it is happening  
now.

**Third Person -**  
Use he, she, it, etc.

**Pictures/Diagrams -**  
What does it look like?

Today, you are going to be writing the third part of your report. To do this you will use your fact sheet. You will be writing about the animal's diet.

**Diet** means the kinds of food that a person, animal, or community habitually eats.



Animals have different diets. Some animals are carnivores, which means they only eat meat. Other, animals are omnivores, which means they eat meat and plants. Some, animals are herbivores, which mean they eat plants, fruits and nuts.

# How do we write about the animal's diet?

## The subheading for animal's diet

- Write about what the animal eats
- Define if the animal is an omnivore, carnivore or herbivore
- Write about what the diet of the animal's young



## **Remember:**

- To use capital letters, full stops and adjectives to make your writing more interesting..
- Remember to use conjunctions to add more information.
