Non-chronological reports

Does anyone know what a non-chronological report is?

Non-chronological reports don't have to be read in **any order**.



Features of a non-chronological report:

Introduction -
What is the report about?

Sub-headings -
Separate your information.

Paragraphs -
Facts about your topic.

Present Tense -
Imagine it is happening
now.

Third Person -
Use he, she, it, etc.

Pictures/Diagrams -
What does it look like?

How do we write the title?

An title must have the following:

- Your title must be eye catching sentence opener.
- Your title must relate to the report

For example:

Pandas
Zebras
Foxes



How do we write the introduction?

An introduction must have the following:

- Your introduction must start with an eye catching sentence opener. For examples: There are different types of animals... or This report is about...
- You are only telling the readers what the report is about.
- Your introduction does not need to be long. It only needs to be a few sentences.
