It has a while since you may have seen family or Grandparents. Why not get a piece of paper and draw what you have been doing at home. You might draw yourself with your parents/siblings. Have a go at writing a short word or your name. Then with an adult's help put it in an envelope and send it to your Grandparents or a family member you haven't seen in a while. Can you stick the stamp on?


Have fun making a den at home! To make a den, you can use chairs and blankets. If it's nice weather, you could make one outside, and then have a picnic or read a story. What did you do in your den?



In summer, it starts to get warm and we see the sun more! There tends to be more sunshine in our day. Can you design your own sun at home? You could hang up in your room to brighten your day! What shape is the sun? What colour is the sun? How big do you think the sun is?


Go on a number hunt around your house! You could search for different places in your house where there are numbers. Be a number spy and take photos of where the numbers are. Eg - clocks, oven, fridge. Can you say the number name? Eg - it is 6.





Keep a weather diary over the week. When you go out for your daily walk with an adult, tell them what the weather is like. Is it hot? Warm? Chilly? Raining? Then when you go home write/draw what the weather was like. By the end of the week, you could decide whether it was mostly warm, cold, raining etc this week.

Read a story that you like with an adult. Then can you retell the story back to your adult. What was your favourite part? Who was the main character? What happens at the end? Why not draw parts of the story on a piece of paper?



When you play in your garden or in the park during the day, you might notice shadows. Look for your shadow or you could lay out your toys and see the shadows they create. Why not trace around the shadows of your toys?

It's summer time! Why not make your favourite ice cream! Follow this recipe and make your own ice cream. You could create a shopping list with an adult, with what you need and follow each step to make the yummy ice cream. What was your favourite part?
