










# Holiday Homework Tasks

## May 2020 Reception Class

<p>Writing and Drawing Record in your book.</p>  <p>Your book must be handed in on Monday morning after the holiday.</p>	<p>Next half term we will be learning about <b>superheroes</b> (Batman, Spider-Man, Thor, Wonder Woman etc.), and <b>people who help us</b> (police officers, firemen, doctors).</p> <p><b>Read</b> a book about a superhero or person who helps us.</p> <p><b>Draw</b> your favourite superhero or somebody who helps you.</p> <p><b>Write</b> sentences about why they are your favourite characters or how they help you.</p>
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### You need to work on each of these activities every day.

<p>Reading</p> 	<p>Remember to read every day! It's really important to show your family how good you are at reading your book! Practise reading all the high frequency words. (You will find the words list inside your homework book.)</p>
<p>Spoken Language</p> 	<p>Talk about our visit to the temple with your class. With your grown-ups, try to make a model of a place that is special to you. You could use cardboard or plastic to create your models.</p>
<p>Numeracy</p> 	<p>We have been solving number problems in class. Complete the activities below.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Find double 3 and write the number sentence.</li> <li>2. Share 6 apples between 2 groups. How many in each group?</li> <li>3. Draw a triangle, square and circle into your book. Colour in <i>half</i> of each shape.</li> </ol>
<p>Handwriting</p> 	<p>Practise writing all the numbers and letters every day.</p> <p>   </p>

Make some really wild art! Collect some natural objects, such as leaves and twigs from your garden or park and get creating! You could make a collage picture or a fabulous model.
