

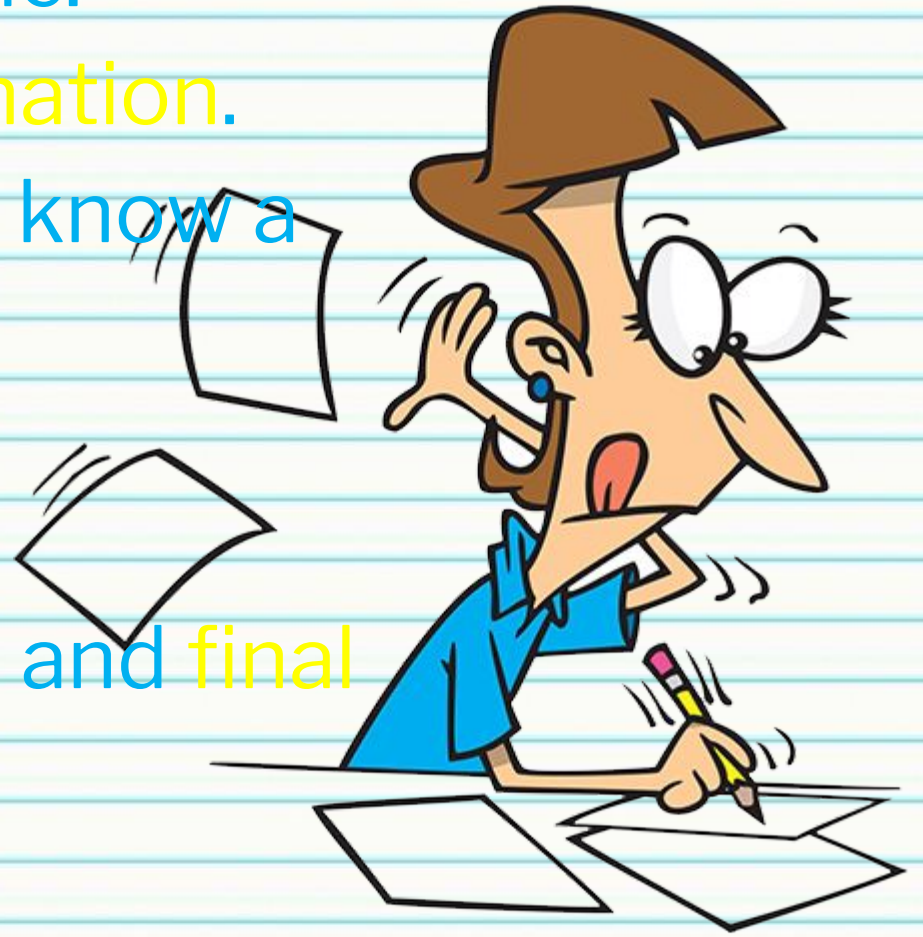
L.O: To identify the features of a non-chronological report.

Non-chronological reports

Does anyone know what a non-chronological report is?

Purpose:

- Non-chronological reports don't have to be read in **any order**.
- Aim to give us information on a topic.
- Written to give other people **information**.
- Useful for **studying** things we don't know a lot about.
- Written in **paragraphs**.
- Contain an **introduction, main body and final paragraph**.
- Reports contain specific **features**.



Features of a non-chronological report:

Title

this is found at the beginning of the whole report/book

introduction

this tells the reader a little bit about the topic and makes them want to read on

Heading

this is found at the beginning of a section.

Sub-heading

This is found at the beginning of each paragraph within a section

paragraphs

we organise our writing into these

picture

this supports the text

caption

this tells us what's happening in the picture
