

Year 2 Holiday Homework

For the half term we would like you to take this opportunity to catch up on your work. Also in the coming weeks we will be looking at the unit 'Time' in Maths. Your task is to create a clock using any materials that you can find at home. Remember to add the numerals (numbers) from 1 to 12 and create two hands. One hand should be longer (minute hand) and one should be shorter (hour hand). Ask an adult to show you how to read o'clock, half-past, quarter-past and quarter-to times. Once you have learnt to read the time they can test you by showing you a time for you to read and they can give you a time for you to show them on your clock by moving the hands to the correct place.

Step 6: A completed clock with hands and numbers.	<p><u>An example on how to make a clock</u></p> <p>You will need: papers, file folder, scissors, glue, craft knife (to cut the small holes)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Print out the template. Cut out all the parts for the clock hands and make holes in the clock body and the 2 clock hands.2. Cut and fold the pivot as in the photo.3. Put the pivot through the hole in the clock body from the back as in the photo. You need to wiggle it a bit so it goes through the hole.4. Put the two clock hands through the pivot. The short hour hand first, then the long minute one.5. Carefully put glue on the top of the pivot (where it's marked with arrows) and stick the red pivot cover. Make sure the glue doesn't get on to the clock hands.6. Check if the clock hands move freely. Done! Cut the rest of the numbers and words to play.
