Monday - Sorting 2D shapes

Click on the link below.

Select '**Is it a triangle?**' from the left list and '**Does it have a right angle?**' from the right list.

Place the shapes in the correct place on the Venn diagram.

If it fits both criteria, place it in the middle. If it fits neither criteria, place it on the outside.

Click 'check' to see if you were right!

Next, select '**Is it a quadrilateral?**' and '**Does it have 1 or more lines of symmetry?**'

Play the game and remember to let your teacher know how you got on.

Tuesday - Sorting 3D shapes

Select '**Does it have a curved surface?**' from the left list and '**Does it have 6 or more flat faces?**' from the right list.

Place the shapes in the correct place on the Venn diagram.

If it fits both criteria, place it in the middle. If it fits neither criteria, place it on the outside.

Click 'check' to see if you were right!

Next, select '**Is it a pyramid?**' and '**Does it have an even number of vertices?**'

Play the game and remember to let your teacher know how you got on.
