

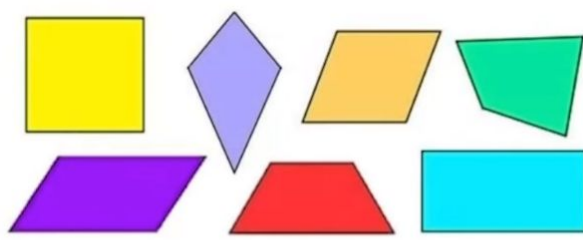
Week 7
