Ourselves

Draw, paint or make a picture of yourself. Look in a mirror to see your facial features such as the colour of your hair and eyes. Can you add this

to your picture?



Recognising and writing their name



Children need to practise looking at and recognising their name, as well as writing their name. Children should learn to write with a capital letter to start and the rest of the name lower case. Eg. David

Counting and recognising numbers


Look at and count numbers in order and also recognise them randomly.

Practise counting objects one at a time and counting a specific number of objects. Look for numbers around you during your day and use during your play.



Looking for shapes

Look at and name the shapes square, triangle, circle and rectangle. Now go on a shape hunt and look around you and see if you can find those shapes anywhere in your house. You could collect some objects and sort them into shape groups Eg clock is a circle.



Read a story

Share your child's favourite story or share your favourite story from your childhood. Talk to them about what they see and what is happening.

Encourage them to think about what might happen next and describe the characters in the story.

Expressing themselves

Allow time for your child to express themselves in different ways. Sing songs they know as well as encourage them to make up their own stories/songs.

Encourage them to use their imagination when playing.
