Task 1 - ENGLISH: Next term we will be learning to write instructions. Make sure you include:

- The resources you have used (e.g. ingredients)
- Equipment you have used
- Each step (using numbers or bullet points)
- Pictures for each step
- Time conjunctions for the start of each step (firstly, secondly, then, next, after that, finally)

Task 3: MATHS

For your maths task we would like you to:

- Practise forming the numbers 0-20 correctly.
- Read and write number 0-20 in digits and in words.
- Write down and practise number bonds to 10 and then to 20 e.g. $17 + 3 = 20$.
- Log onto SplashLearn to complete the activities set.



Task 4—Science

In Science, we are going to be looking at plants including trees and flowers! Our focus scientist is Beatrix Potter.

Your task is to create a poster of a model of a plant and label the different parts of a plant that you have chosen.



Task 5 - HISTORY

We are going to be studying Manor Park; looking at significant people, events and places. Your task is to ask an adult questions about the changes that have occurred in the local area from when they were young and growing up to the way it is now.
