

Intent

At Essex, we believe every child is creative, and so equip them with the knowledge, skills and opportunities to become visual thinkers. Our curriculum is designed to develop imagination and creativity, enabling pupils to:

- Think, observe and analyse the world around them
- Improve their mastery of Art & DT skills and techniques through drawings, paintings and sculptures
- Develop the skills, concepts and knowledge necessary for them to express responses to ideas and experiences in visual forms
- Express themselves, their views, feelings and opinions imaginatively

The Art & DT curriculum inspires and engages all our pupils, by linking their learning to other subject areas through themes including, 'Other Worlds' and 'Made of More'. Its content is inclusive and diverse, allowing all pupils access to the world's most inspirational artists and influential art and design movements from a range of cultures and epochs - thus helping to engender an appreciation of human creativity and achievement.

Implementation

Pupils are delivered a vocabulary rich curriculum, which is essential to successful acquisition of knowledge, skills and understanding of the subjects. We believe that practical hands-on skills based projects are essential in developing pupils' understanding, creativity and innovation. It teaches our pupils real life skills, bridging the gap from where they are now and potentially what they can become.

Each year group have six units, three Art and Design units and three DT units. The curriculum is designed to develop our pupils' critical abilities and understanding of their own and others heritage through studying key artists to show diversity and representation of different cultures. Key skills are also identified and mapped across each year group to show progression. Our key focus on skills means that pupils are given the opportunity to practise and develop mastery in all aspects of Art & DT, this is supported by a wide range of quality resources, which are used to support pupils' confidence in the use of different media. We also have an art day and exhibition, which is linked to Black History Month, showcasing pupils' achievements. Art and DT are also both embedded through cross-curricular links, where pupils participate in a creative activity for special events in school.

Impact

Outstanding teaching and learning practices are embedded at the core of Art and DT lessons making links to the wider world. Pupils are provided with opportunities to develop transferrable skills and attributes that can be used beyond school. Each unit introduces an inspirational artist to enable pupils to recognise and be familiar with their contribution to the Arts, this makes pupils more confident in expressing their ideas and evaluating their own and others' work. Monitoring of Art and DT planning and sketch books allows us to quality assure curriculum coverage and progression of skills throughout the
