

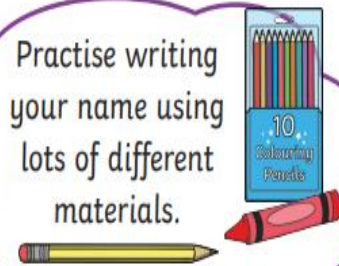


## Summer Holiday Homework July 2022

Complete this **All About Me** booklet to introduce yourself to your new teacher.

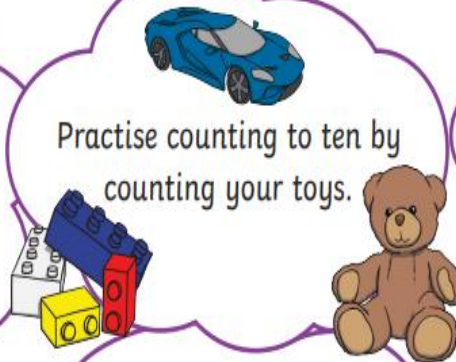


Practise writing your name using lots of different materials.

Play 'I Spy' with someone at home to become familiar with sounds.



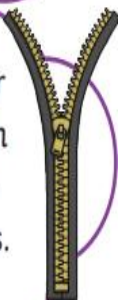
Talk about some of the school **rules** you will have to follow.

Try zipping your jacket, putting on your shoes and fastening buttons.

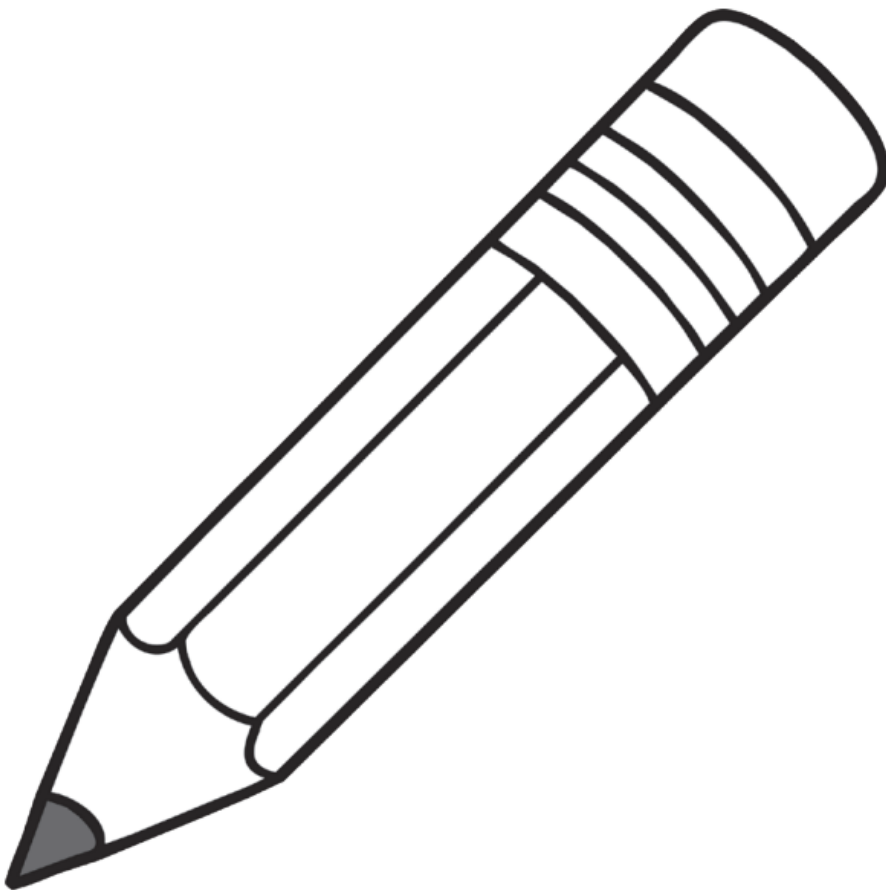

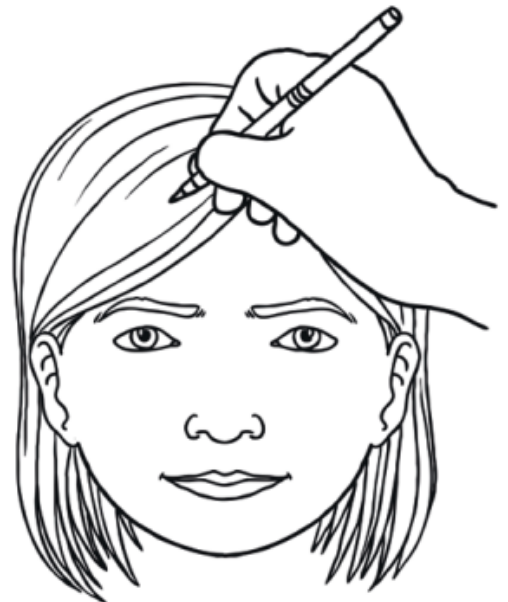

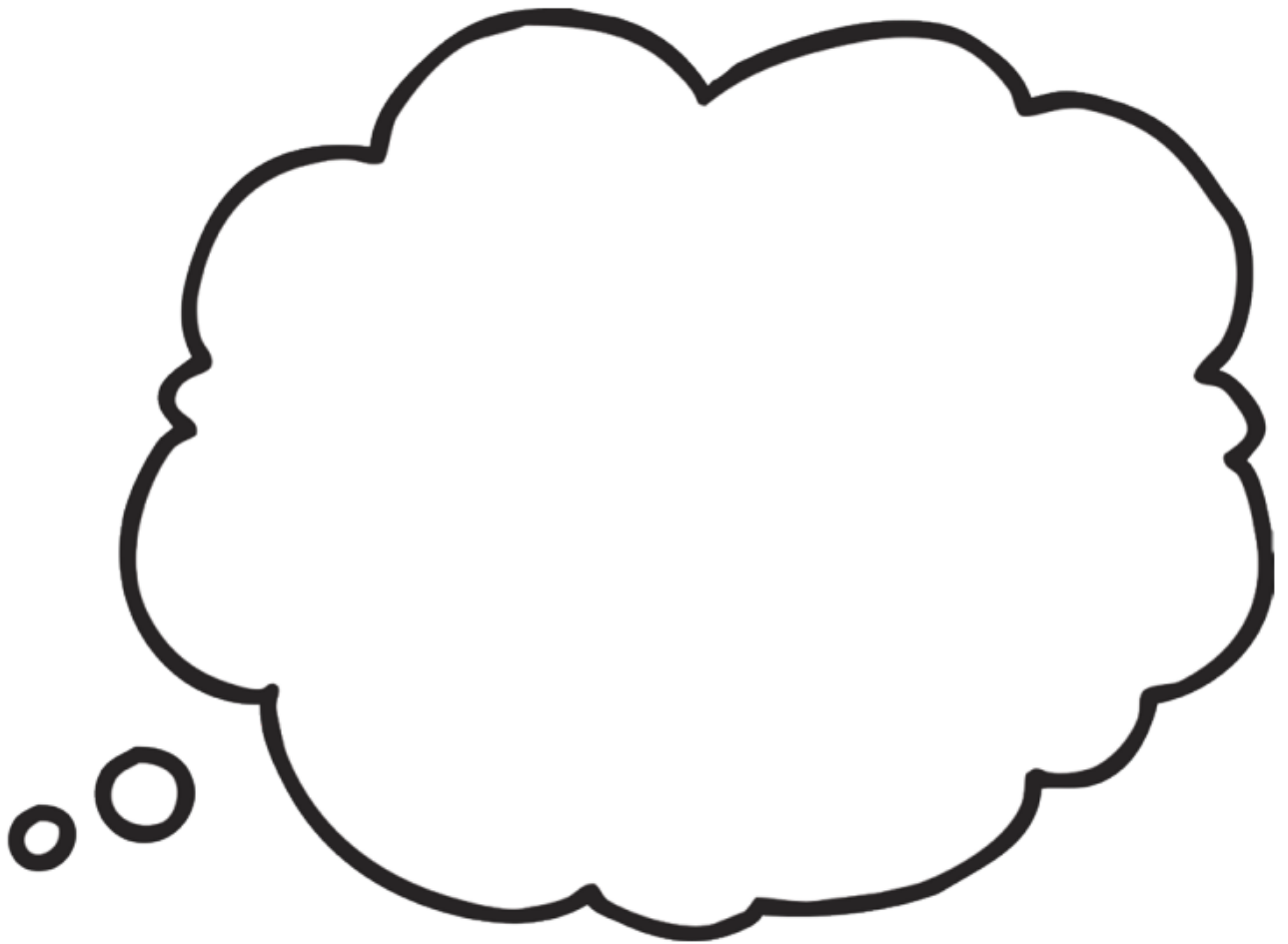
