


Invaders - The Romans

We will be learning about the Romans in the spring term. We would like you to carry out some research about 'The Romans' and find out as much information as you can. Here are some of the activities we would like you to complete:

Model Designing and Making



Design and make a Roman related model, e.g. you could use local Roman remains to inspire you to create a villa, forum, temple or stadium. Research and write a factfile about Roman life. Visit the Museum of London and see the underground Roman amphitheatre at the Guildhall in the City of London.


