

Year 2 Visit to the Science Museum



On Tuesday 13th and Wednesday 14th June, Year 2 visited the Science Museum in South Kensington. During their visit, pupils explored the space gallery and were able to see a real piece of the moon, as well as satellites and a range of spacecraft. They listened to information about the moon, Earth and Mars. They also saw a real space suit and read information about astronauts; this draws on their prior learning from year one when they researched Mae Jemison in science. Pupils will be able to use their experience at the science museum in their DT lessons this half term when they design and make a space glove. During the visit, they also explored the Pattern Pod Gallery. This is an interactive
