

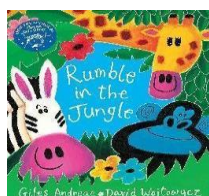
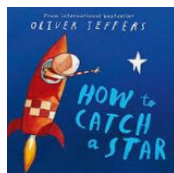
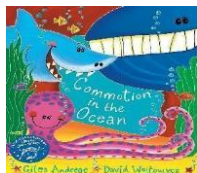


Holiday Home learning Reception

<p>Reading</p> 	<p>Remember to read every day! You have books in your book bag. You can also log on to the Bug Club to read books every day. Here is the website for Bug Club: https://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk/login?c=0 Practise reading and writing these words: I, the, no, go, to he, she, so, of, off</p>
<p>Writing</p> 	<p>Can you practise writing your name at home? Do you remember all of the letters? Are they correctly formed? Draw a picture of your holiday, e.g. playing at home, going outside, or eating dinner with family.</p>
<p>Spoken Language</p> 	<p>Winter Walk Go on a sensory winter walk with an adult. Talk about: What can you see? What can you smell or hear? You can draw a winter picture and label it after your walk.</p>
<p>Numeracy</p>	<p>Can you count up to 10? Can you hop 5 times? Can you jump 4 times? Can you spot any numerals on your street? Practise writing numerals 1-10.</p>
<p>Brushing Our Teeth</p> 	<p>We should brush our teeth twice a day for around two minutes. Brushing properly removes plaque, which can cause cavities, toothache, gum disease, and tooth loss. It also gives us a lovely fresh breath.</p>
