

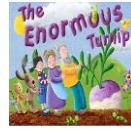
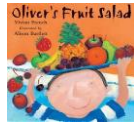


# Easter Holiday Home Learning Reception

Writing Steps for Brushing Teeth:

- "First, I put a pea-sized blob of toothpaste on my toothbrush."
- "Then, I wet my toothbrush under the tap."
- "Next, I brush my teeth in small circles for two minutes."
- "After that, I rinse my mouth with water."
- "Finally, I spit out the toothpaste and rinse my toothbrush."
