#### <u>Summary</u>:

During the half term break, we would like you to complete projects based on topics that you will be learning about after holidays.

#### <u>Science</u>

Next term in Science we will be exploring different animals. We would like pupils to create a poster exploring different types of animals (for example different types of birds, mammals, amphibians, repsites, insects, etc.)

### Geography:

In Summer 1 pupils will be looking at climate and weather. We would like pupils to create a weather chart during the holidays to record how the weather has changed/stayed the same over their half term.

### <u>Art</u>

Next term, pupils will be looking at contemporary art by Andy Goldsworthy. We would like pupils to bring in different natural materials that they can create patterns from. We would like for pupils to trial this at home and see what patterns and shapes they can make. (things pupils could use; stones, soil, sand, sticks, bricks, pebbles, marbles.)

### <u>Maths</u>

Next term we will begin the term by learning about multiplication and division. We would like pupils to create different multiplication sentences using objects around the house/drawing pictures.
