

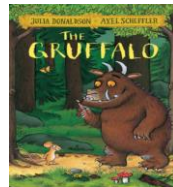
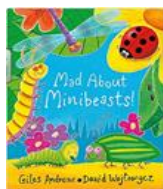


Reception Home Learning

<p>English</p> <p>We would like you to practice writing in your purple book daily from Monday to Friday during your holiday.</p> <p>Every day, write down one thing you did during your holiday. You can also draw a picture to accompany it. For example, on Monday, I played with my brother; on Tuesday, I went to the park; and on Wednesday, I brushed my teeth.</p> <p>Use your phonics to spell different words and write all the letters correctly.</p>	
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Can you find 2D and 3D shapes in your local environment? Go for a walk with your grown-up and see what shapes you can find. Can you make a shape picture from what you have seen? Draw one in your purple book.</p> 
 <p>Eat foods that help to make your teeth strong.</p> <p>Brush your teeth twice a day.</p> <p>Drink water or milk.</p> <p>Visit the dentist.</p>
