6. When did she die?

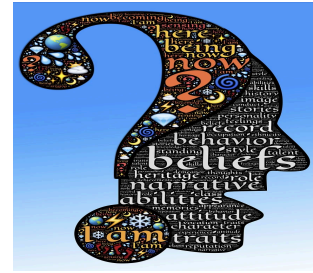
