



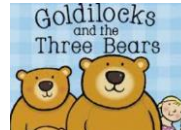
Half-Term Holiday Home Learning Nursery October 2024

Here are your child's home learning activities for this term. The teaching staff have selected some activities to support your child's learning this term and encourage them to become independent learners. Please choose and do some of these activities with your child.

<p><u>Get Reading</u></p> <p>The children will be bringing home their Nursery reading book. Please read this story with your child, asking questions about the pictures and characters and discussing what is happening in the story. We hope you enjoy this special reading time with your child.</p> <p>Speaking and Listening: During the holiday, please talk to your children about what they do to celebrate their special days, such as Birthdays, Weddings, Eid, Diwali, Guru Nanak's Birthday, and Christmas.</p> 	<p><u>Get Mathematical</u></p> <p>When you are out and about, have a look at different numbers. What numbers can you find? Where are they? If you can, take a photograph and bring it to school so we can put it on our display.</p> <p><u>Name Recognition:</u></p> <p>Practice reading their name – When writing their name, use a capital letter for the first and lowercase letters. Remember to keep practising!</p>
<p><u>Notice for Parents:</u></p> <p>Please ensure ALL clothing items and water bottles have your child's name on them. This will help us quickly locate the owner!</p> <p><u>Attendance and Punctuality:</u> Regular school attendance is essential to giving children the best possible start in life. Please make sure your children are attending school every day.</p> 	<p><u>Get Creative</u></p> <p>Go on an autumn walk with a grown-up and collect some autumn leaves, conkers, acorns, pinecones, and twigs. Please bring them back to the nursery to show to your friends.</p>
