



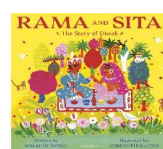
# Half-Term Holiday Home Learning Reception October 2024







Dear Parents/Carers,

Our topic for next term will be "Let's Celebrate". Developing an understanding of celebrations throughout the world and celebrating each other's differences is a crucial aim for this learning topic. Our learning journey will also be about celebrating ourselves.

**Books they will explore:**



Here are your child's home learning activities for this term. The teaching staff have selected some activities to support your child's learning this term and encourage them to become independent learners. Please choose and do some of these activities with your child.

<p><b><u>Get Reading</u></b></p> <p>Read a selection of story books with your child. Which is your favourite book? What happens in the story? Can you act it out? Challenge: Can you draw your favourite character?</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Speaking</u></b></p> <p>Talk about the different times when we need to say "please," "thank you," "no thank you," "excuse me," and "pardon." For example, when someone shares a toy with us, or we don't want what we are offered.</p>	<p><b><u>Get Creative</u></b></p> <p>Find leaves or other natural objects and make a picture or pattern.</p> 	<p><b><u>Get Mathematical</u></b></p> <p>Ask your child to help you get your items when you go shopping. E.g. 3 bananas, 4 carrots or 1 tin of baked beans. Support your child to count out the correct number of items. Model the number in a sentence and ask your child to repeat it. E.g. "I have 3 bananas"</p> 
<p><b><u>Notice for Parents:</u></b></p> <p>This is a gentle reminder to please read with your children every day for 10 - 15 minutes and sign their reading record each day. Please ensure that the reading record and reading book come to school every day. Please ensure your child brings a school book bag to school every day.</p> <p>Please ensure ALL clothing items have your child's name on them. This will help us quickly locate the owner! Also, please send the PE bag to school on Monday.</p> <p>Please continue to encourage your child to get dressed independently. This will help them when getting changed for PE.</p>		<p><b><u>Get Active</u></b></p> <p>Can you complete at least three exercise sessions a week? How many star jumps can you do?
