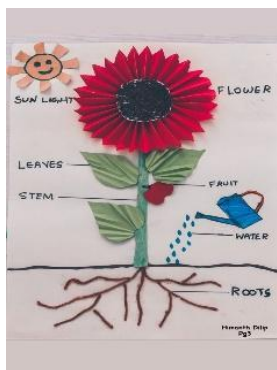


## Science
